**Description:** The Department of Physical Education originally fell under the Division of Social Sciences and with successive organizational restructuring has been part of the College of Arts & Sciences and the College of Science and Mathematics. From 1988 2000 the Physical Education Department was combined with the Biology Department to form the Department of Life Sciences chaired by the Chairman of the Biology Department. With the addition of the Athletic Training Program in Fall of 2000, the Physical Education Department became the stand-alone Department of Kinesiology. Two subsequent organizational transfer changes have occurred: one in AY 2013-2014 to the College of Nursing and Allied Health, and another in AY 2014-2015 to the College of Health Sciences. The latter transfer did not include the Physical Education Program which was transferred to the School of Education which subsequently was renamed the College of Education in AY2018-2019.

In 1994 the Department added an emphasis in Sports Medicine and Athletic Training which evolved into the Athletic Training Program which became fully accredited Fall, 2003. This undergraduate program was phased out in AY2015-2016 and replaced with the Master of Athletic Training Program (MAT) offered by the College of Health Sciences.

Collection includes annual reports and action plans, assessment plans and reports, internal self-studies, consultative reports, and reports submitted to accrediting agencies. Prior to 1993-1994 annual reports consisted of planning schedule that outlined departmental goals and objectives.
