**Description:** *Faculty Accomplishments* is an annual listing of outstanding faculty accomplishments which "pays special tribute to those who have distinguished themselves during the previous academic year through excellence in teaching, scholarship, performance, research and service..[enhancing] the University's mission of excellence in a Christian environment" (Dr. A. Kennerley Bonnette, Provost and Vice President for Academic Affairs). Brochures are published and distributed at the beginning of the Fall semester.

*The Academic Profile of Baptist College Faculty* lists colleges and universities where faculty of major departments earned academic credentials. Documents entitled *Faculty Profile* include annual statistics on the total number of faculty, number or percentage with tenure and the overall average salary; breakdowns by academic rank on gender, average salaries; a five year range of average faculty salaries and average faculty raises; number of adjuncts and courses taught by adjuncts versus full-time faculty. Reports dated prior to AY 1987-1988 consist of those submitted to outside agencies. Beginning with AY 1987-1988 reports are compiled internally and distributed within the organization. Beginning with AY1988-1989 reports also includes average salaries for peer private colleges in South Carolina, and three designated peer Baptist institutions of higher education.
