**Description:**

Collection includes annual reports and action plans, assessment plans and reports, internal self-studies, consultative reports, in-house statistical reports, and reports submitted to accrediting agencies. Prior to 1993 annual reports consisted of planning schedules that outlined departmental goals and objectives.

Enrollment Data statistical reports usually cover headcounts for one academic year or semester and are broken down by various characteristics. Headcounts for Fall 1982 and Fall 1983 are also broken down by the number of dormitory, commuting, Baptist, and international students plus leading vocational choices, degrees granted in past year, and the number of FT and PT faculty and percentage of full time faculty holding the Ph.D.

Enrollment Trends cover a range of years and include headcounts broken down by full-time, part-time, and FTEs. Some include percentage change in enrollment, retention figures, and number of credit hours generated. Most are based on BCC HEGIS Reports.
